## **Frequently Asked Questions**

## How much will it cost and how long will it take?

Good question! The fact is, learning to fly requires a significant dedication of both time and money. More precisely, the minimum flight time required by the FAA to attain a PPL is 40hrs, the national average is around 70hrs. You will see from my attached lesson plan that you can anticipate close to 50hrs. The FAA doesn't set a minimum for ground instruction, but if you choose to train with me you can expect equal parts ground & flight instruction.

Part 2, money. The short answer is, if you budget \$10,000 start to finish, you won't be too far off. The longer answer follows:

C152 (\$80/hr)

C172 (\$139/hr)

<u>Note:</u> The above figures are rough, but realistic estimates of what costs you can expect. I don't quote FAA minimums as they simply are not realistic in this day and age of flight training.
