Born and raised in Boston, Alice Worthington Ball studied at the Boston Museum of Fine Arts under Frank W. Benson (1862-1951) and Edmund C. Tarbell (1862-1938). She studied in Paris under Gustave-Claude-Étienne Courtois (1852-1923) and Raphaël Collin (1850-1916), and in Holland under George Hitchcock (1850-1913).

During her lifetime, Ball exhibited with the Paris Salon; Boston Art Club; Art Institute of Chicago; Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts; Connecticut Academy of Fine Arts; North Shore Art Association; Salons of America; Society of Independent Artists.
