

## Covid Safety Protocols

### Before the Shoot

- Contact Jennifer if you have been in contact with a covid-19 positive person within the last 14 Days. You will not be able to participate in the project.
  - What counts as close contact? Per the Center for Disease Control:
    - You were within 6 feet of someone who has COVID-19 for a total of 15 minutes or more
    - You provided care at home to someone who is sick with COVID-19
    - You had direct physical contact with the person (hugged or kissed them)
    - You shared eating or drinking utensils
- Contact Jennifer if you have tested positive for Covid-19 within the past 14 days. You will not be able to participate in the project.
- We ask that you follow the CDC guidelines outside of work to reduce your risk of exposure to Covid-19.
- Please consider not taking the project if you have engaged in personal activities that put you at higher risk to Covid-19 exposure.

### Shoot Days

- Daily each person will self-monitor for fever and Covid symptoms
- Sick Individuals must stay home
- Be fever free for 24 hours
- Contact Jennifer if someone in your family is sick. You will not be able to participate in the project.
- Anyone with a fever, or with any symptoms of Covid-19 (cough, fever, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell) is NOT permitted in the shoot, regardless of booking status and should immediately contact Jennifer.

### At the Shoot

- Masks Required & must be worn covering nose and mouth
- Practice social distancing of 6ft
- Workflow to be arranged in such a way to minimize any cross-departmental contact
- Communal work areas to be limited to single-department use at any time
- Clean hands often
- Cover coughs and sneezes
- Disinfect your work area

### After the Shoot

- If you begin to show symptoms or test positive for COVID-19 within 2 weeks after the photoshoot or have been in contact who tests positive please report to Jennifer immediately.
- Detailed information will be kept confidential but an exposure notice will be sent to crew/attendees.
