**the guest book**

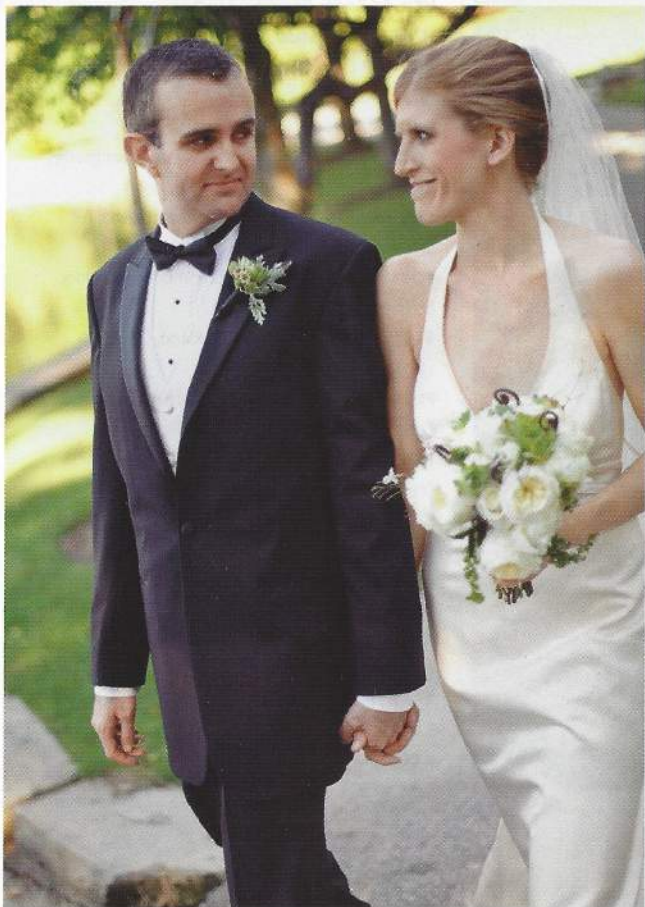
In lieu of a traditional guest book, guests wrote notes on vintage postcards and dropped them into a small, antique mailbox.
