And what a celebration it was. Islanders from the six Marquesan islands gathered on the host island of Nuku Hiva for five days of dancing, singing and feasting. Each island group had spent months preparing their costumes and rehearsing their performances and as much as we already knew about the extraordinary cultural revitalisation on these islands, nothing could have prepared us for the emotional impact of seeing this once dormant culture now so strong and proud. that, against almost insurmountable odds, culture and language can survive to thrive again. The sense of community identity and pride was palpable and full of joy. We were swept up in the excitement and in the knowledge that this culture is here to stay and to become ever stronger.

If only more societies could come together like this, in peace and dance and song and joy to focus only on their commonalities, and not their differences, and to celebrate their love for their community and their common home.

We were proud just to be there to see it and to be a small part of it and we are so very grateful for all of you who have supported us and continue to support us. Phase 2 of the project (the creation of a cultural and ocean conservation center, complete with living museum and botanical garden) here we come! Thank you.
