Shannon Fagan is a recognized photographic industry expert with respect to production standards, creative mapping and aesthetic trends, marketing, assignment procurement, pricing and sales, and licensing models for both analog and digital works in the image licensing industry. He began his career in the photography industry in the late 1990s with work experiences at The Metropolitan Museum of Art (Curatorial Photographs Department / Walker Evans Archive), Magnum Photos (archive & licensing / annual meeting), and Fairchild Publications (production and fashion editorial).

The Stock Artists Alliance (SAA) elected Shannon as their culminating President in 2009 to merge the organization with the Professional Photographers of America (PPA) in Atlanta.

First, in the capacity of rapidly evolving competitive assignment projects for organizations such as McCann Erickson, Bozell Lowe Advertising, and the New York Times, for end-use clientele such Verizon, General Electric, BMW, and The United Way.
