

- The banner venue along Niles Blvd. includes approximately 32 (low-mount) banner poles on the west side of the historic core. The initial intent is to fill all of these positions with with the Niles Cultural Arts Banners. The street intersection and east side (high-mount) banner locations will remain open for announcing the annual events held in the historic district. In total there are approximately 62 banner location in the Historic Core of Niles.
- Financial support of this program is provided through tax deductible donations from groups or individuals interested in funding the printing costs of each banner. Recognition of financial contributions will be through community gratefulness and personal pride.
- The physical banner remains the property of the Niles Community as administered by the Niles Main Street Association.










1926 **KRAFTILE** 1996

at the Niles Elementary School Manufactured in NILES, California








at the Ellsworth Building Manufactured in NILES, California




1884 Niles, California 500 Acres












