

## **Construction Documentation: Open Wall Virtual Tours**

- Distribution of Tour at time of sale adding value for buyer and much more.

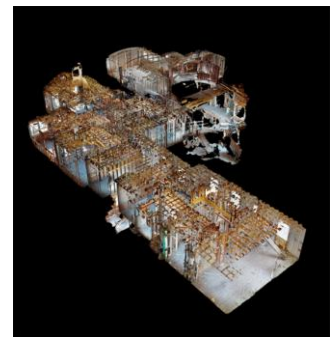
### **What is an Open Walls Virtual Tour?**

An OWVT is a user-navigable 3D tour (not a video) of the project interior after all of the MEP is roughed in. It is created before the insulation and drywall are installed. The OWVT visually documents the actual placement/size of every element of the build for a completely immersive experience..

### **What can you do inside an Open Walls Virtual Tour?**

- Walk through a project as if you are there
- A Notes feature allows you to have conversations and share files with collaborators directly in your tour. Create punch list items for subs.
- Measure anything in the tour
- Tag/label items in the tour with, PDF's, video, text, add external links, things like manufacturer info attached to hardware for example\*
- Embed the tour into any website
- Share the tour with a direct link
- View individual floor plans
- Order high resolution photos from the tour\*
- Order measured 2d floor plans\*
- Create a walkthrough slide show\*
