

Faroe Islands Workshop 2019

I've just returned from a shoot in the Faroe Islands, which is quite simply one of the most stunning and deeply beautiful places I've ever been. I had a fantastic time shooting sunrises at 4.00am and sunsets at 11.00pm (in June), and produced some great shots. Being in the Gulf Stream, the Faroe Islands are more temperate than you might think, but there are still big swings in the weather most days which is perfect for shooting. A temperature range of around 5-12° Celsius is typical for June.



The Faroe Islands is a group of 18 islands about halfway between Iceland and Norway. It has dramatic mountains, cliffs and fjords, and is a real photographers heaven. The weather is unpredictable which is one of its charms. I arrived with a set of key shots which I wanted to produce along with a rough shoot schedule which I immediately threw out the first day I was there. The weather very much dictates the shoot, not the photographer. There is also great opportunity to shoot bird life along the way, most particularly on the island of Mykines where there are colonies of Puffins and many other species.

The main game is to go to the best spots in the right light to get great shots. This workshop is for photographers who are passionate about "getting the shot" and happy to put in the effort required to do so. I am a professional landscape photographer, and I usually run only one or two workshops a year to places I love. You can be assured of helpful relevant knowledge which will greatly improve the way you see and produce shots. I have a wealth of experience which I'm happy to share and a great passion for the Faroe Islands. So you are assured of an enjoyable and informative time shooting in this brilliant location.

Given my love for the Faroe Islands, I thought it was a great idea to offer a workshop there to share the experience with like minded photographers, and head back in 2019. I hope you can come along.

About the Workshop.

Dates: May 27th to June 3rd 2019.

Duration: 8 Days, 7 Nights.

Skill level: From amateur to professional.

Participants: A maximum of 6 photographers.

Start and finish at Vagar Airport, Faroe Islands.

Workshop leader: Peter Dunphy.

Investment: \$8,975.00 AUD pp. (no single supplement charge)

Inclusions.

All airport transfers.

Accommodation in a premium quality four star Hotel in Torshavn for 7 nights in a single room.

All meals, breakfast lunch and dinner.

All transport for the workshop duration.

All photography guide services.

Exclusions.

Any pre or post workshop travel, international and domestic flights and pre and post workshop accommodation expenses.

Any taxes, insurances, levies, immigration duties, passport or Visa fees.

The workshop investment is based on the price for one person only... partners most welcome at extra full rate per person.

Fitness level.

Moderate fitness is required for this workshop. A number of the key locations include hikes of about 2 hours return over uneven ground. One of the best locations involves a 40 minute return hike over rocky, potentially slippery steep terrain. The hike to see the puffins on Mykines is around 4 hours return.

Mobile (Cell) phone access.

There is good mobile coverage throughout the Faroe Islands. Our accommodation has free WiFi.

Payment Terms.

A non refundable deposit of \$1,500.00 AUD. pp. to secure your place.

The balance of payment in full no later than 90 Days before the start date of May 27, 2019...

all payments to be received no later than February 27, 2019.

Itinerary & Weather.

As mentioned previously the shooting schedule in the Faroe Islands is very much driven by the weather, for example, the ferry to Mykines does not always operate if the seas are too rough, some locations really need bright light where others work well in the rain or a storm... the Mulafossur waterfall shot (below) was produce in a full gale with 90km/h winds and rain. So with that in mind I'm including a photography "hit list" which will vary according to the weather outlook for the day.



I'll meet you at the Airport.


